The Second Mission Impossible: uOttawa students take on AIDS in India

OTTAWA, May 22, 2007 — Children's AIDS Health Program (CAIDSHP) is preparing to embark on another mission. The organization, led by uOttawa student Shamin Mohamed Jr., is trekking to India from June 15th to July 4th, 2007 in order to create a difference for children infected or affected by HIV and AIDS.

India Mission 2007: Realizing a Vision, will include HIV prevention training and provide local communities with social services, toys and sporting equipment to further improve their lives and build more socially connected communities. CAIDSHP will bring their stories back to Canadian youth, continuing to create awareness about the pandemic and to motivate and encourage youth of all ages to take action.

South Africa 2006, the organization's first trip, impacted the lives of hundreds of youth in that country. During the mission they distributed over 19,000 herbal nutritional tablets, 500 condoms and 250 art supply kits. Their goal was to educate and offer practical ways to improve the lives of children living with HIV and AIDS in a country where one in nine people are infected.

In addition to the Board members of CAIDSHP traveling to India, the organization will be sponsoring two volunteers selected from a nationwide competitive application process. Jesse Janssen, uOttawa student, and Sasha Smith, Capilano College student, have been selected.

Shamin will be available for interviews in Ottawa and Toronto leading up to and after this important trip. Jesse Janssen will be also available for interviews in Ottawa.
